



## OMA ONAM 2017 – Rules

### Dance/Music/Entertainment Entry Rules:

**FOOD AND DRINKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN CARPETED AREAS.**

**STRICTLY ENFORCED BY YUKON FINE ARTS CENTER**

- All participants must be current members of OMA or authorized by OMA committee.
- All entries must be sent to email to the Event Directors (below) before **Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup> 2017.**
- All audio (MP3) /video files must be sent to email to the Event Directors (below) before **Wednesday, September 6<sup>th</sup> 2017.**
- All inquiries related to this event must be sent to any OMA committee member.
- Entries might be auditioned (minimum 2 min.) by the panel of OMA committee on **date** to be determined, if received entries count goes out of desired time frame.
- If too many entries are received, performances showcasing Kerala traditions and Onam would be preferred over westernized Bollywood ones to accommodate entries within time limit of the program.
- **Performing Group Leader(s) are responsible to send non- OMA member participant's details to the Event Directors for OMA Committee's approval before the deadline. (Please DO NOT send dues to OMA mailbox to avoid delay).**
- **Performing Group Leader(s) will be notified once their entry is approved.**
- Songs selection is granted on first come first serve basis. No repetition of songs allowed including the ones in medley or remixes.
- One performer can participate in maximum 2 entries. National Anthem is not counted as a performance.
- Minimum 2 performers are required in any performance, however, up to four solo performances are allowed to maintain verity of programs.
- Maximum duration allowance of performance is 5 minutes. Exception is granted only to Indian Classical dance pieces. Please contact Event Directors to discuss the time length for Classical items.
- All stage costumes should be appropriate and related to the type of performance.
- **Two dressing rooms/changing rooms (one for men and one for women) will be available back-stage for all participants to share. Once your performance is over, please clean up the area for the next group to take over the space. You may decide to dress-up elsewhere, however our suggestion is to take advantage of available dressing rooms to avoid commute delays. Our target is to strictly adhere to time during this entire event.**
- **NO Food or drink is allowed in the Auditorium.**
- Once the event starts, only performers and volunteers will be permitted on stage or back-stage. All parents, helpers and guests must exit to the audience.
- Rules can be added/changed as per discretion of OMA Committee.
